#### **OPPORTUNITIES TO VOLUNTEER**

On August 20, 2021, PSLS is offering a free CLE over the noon hour on adult guardianships. We hope to recruit more volunteer attorneys to assist our clients in navigating the adult guardianship process. More information on this event will be provided in the July 2021 LegalEase article.

In lieu of the cancelled in-person sealing/expungement clinics, PSLS is offering a pro bono opportunity to advise sealing/expungement clients on their record over the phone. PSLS will investigate the client's eligibility to file a Request to Expunge/Seal and if eligible, PSLS will prepare the court documents. We will email the client's documents to you well before you plan to call the client, and we will answer any questions you may have before you call the client. Once you have advised the client over the phone regarding the documents, the client will be empowered to then file the pro se documents. This pro bono commitment typically takes about an hour.
